



The Egg Drop

The Egg Drop Rules

The BRCS Science Club is sponsoring the Egg Drop Contest for the Elementary School, Grades 3-5. Awards will be given for winners in each class! We are excited about this special Event! The rules are simple!

1. The container must be no larger than a shoe box.
2. The egg may be provided that day by the science club. You may not use your own eggs in the contest! If you want to test your container you may use your own egg but we will provide the testing egg!
3. Students may also decorate their containers but the container must be able to be opened to put in the egg and check it each time.
4. Use your imagination of how to protect the egg. Anything can be used except parachutes to break the fall are not allowed.
5. We will weight the conatiner without an egg in it at the start. Have your container ready to be weighed with everything you will need on it. After weighing nothing else can be added except the egg. No tape or anything else!

1. Weigh in.
2. The drop: All drops will be from the 2nd story school window onto concrete. We will check to see if the egg broke, then do a second drop from the same window at a higher
3. The winner will be determined. The winner will have the lighest conatiner with an unbroken egg after both drops.
